Vincent Van Duysen has designed Louisa, a series of round and oval small tables featuring wood and concrete emphasised with an innovative tactile and aesthetic impact. The supportive frame is a conical central plinth, which lifts off the floor and fits into a flat space on the inside. The tops, almost like suspended trays, can be in concrete or wood and stand out thanks to an original starburst pattern, achieved thanks to the special process used to join the strips. The base is made of curved plywood covered with wood or painted curved sheet metal. Objects that can be used in any setting, mixed and matched as desired, with simplicity, lightness, elegance: the quintessence of modern design.


TABLE STRUCTURE (WOOD)

Chipboard panel covered in wood veneer.




## DIMENSIONS
