#### The Heritage Collection

A dialogue between past and future, the Molteni&C Heritage Collection celebrates the work of design masters such as Gio Ponti, Werner Blaser, Yasuhiko Itoh, Ignazio Gardella, and Afra & Tobia Scarpa. These timeless pieces embody the brand's commitment to preserving and reinterpreting iconic design for posterity.

#### Molteni Museum

Established in 2015, the Molteni Museum tells the story of the brand's evolution since 1934 through the vision of its many design collaborators and innovators. Located in the Glass Cube at the Molteni Headquarters, designed by Ron Gilad, the Museum presents a living archive of Molteni&C design excellence.


#### The Pavilion

Located at the company's headquarters in Giussano, Italy, the Pavilion is a 1,400-square-metre hospitality and exhibition space designed by Vincent Van Duysen. The building offers a dynamic environment for cultural events, collaborations, and a deeper exploration of Molteni&C's values.

#### Palazzo Molteni

Inaugurated in 2025 in the heart of Milan, Palazzo Molteni is the brand's premier space, offering an immersive experience that brings the Molteni&C design philosophy to life. Housed in an historic, 19th-century residence spanning seven floors, the Palazzo features Molteni Galleria on the upper two levels, a meeting and reception area that serves as the Milan wing of the Molteni&C Headquarters.





The 2025 Molteni&C Collection is a heartfelt tribute to Milan, with new pieces that peel back the city's layers of history and innovation, honouring its creative past as well as reflecting its future.

Overseen by Vincent Van Duysen, Molteni&C's creative director, the mood of the Collection has been informed by deep research into the **company's archives**, with a focus on exhibitions and projects designed in the **1970s and 1980s**. These historical spaces and objects have now been reinterpreted through a 21st-century lens, resulting in a **light and dynamic ambience** that is perfectly adapted to contemporary life.

In Van Duysen's vision for the Collection, Molteni&C's designs provide the ideal scenography for a spacious open-plan apartment in an elegant, residential area of Milan – a reflection of the city's grand past, as well as the **modern aesthetics, details and design excellence** that have always defined Molteni&C.

The mood of the Collection plays with the relationship between **historical architecture and contemporary cosmopolitanism**. In this respect, the Collection offers a perfect reflection of the values of the newly opened **Palazzo Molteni** in the city's Via Manzoni: a historic space that provides an international hub for design and marks a new chapter in Molteni&C's history.

Nella visione di Van Duysen per la Collezione, i design di Molteni&C forniscono la scenografia ideale per uno spazioso appartamento open-space in un'elegante zona residenziale di Milano, a riflesso del **grande passato della città**, così come dell'estetica moderna, dei dettagli e **dell'eccellenza del design** che hanno sempre contraddistinto Molteni&C.

Il mood della Collezione gioca con il rapporto tra **architettura storica e cosmopolitismo contemporaneo**. 




